Yes, you can ride on the highway anywhere in the travel lane.

But there are some good choices to make and those are provided by the cages. When riding our bikes, we should follow in their tracks.

This should make it easier for us to be seen in the side mirrors and the rearview mirror from inside the cage.

By riding in their tire tracks, you increase traction because of the rubber put down by

other vehicles. The tires on these vehicles also clean the lanes of debris for example, sand, rocks, bolts, screws and other hazards.

By traveling in these lanes, you lessen the chance of getting oil on your tires. Not only is the oil slick, but it will pick up sand on your tires.

So, ride safe and pick your lane carefully!!
