

Tallahassee H.O.G. Pre-ride Checklist

1. Does everyone have plenty of fuel?
2. Does anyone need to use the restroom?
3. Is anyone's bike still in "break-in"?
4. Is anyone a new rider or new to group riding?
5. We ride in staggered formation. (explain)
6. Anyone not a current member of National H.O.G. AND our Tallahassee H.O.G. Chapter? If so, fill out waiver/release form. Explain that it is extremely important that both memberships are in good standing.
7. Go over hand/foot signals.
8. Pass back all hand (or foot) signals; it's important for the Tail Gunner to get the signals.
9. Explain Tail Gunner's job – securing the lane, checking on bikes who drop out unexpectedly.
10. Don't run red lights. We'll wait for you if you get caught behind a red light. (explain)
11. Go over changing lanes – follow the bike in front of you, not the Tail Gunner.
12. Go over turn lanes – follow the bike in front of you.
13. I'll drive not more than 5 mph over/under the speed limit. Is everyone OK with that?
14. No alcohol before or during the ride.
15. The ride is over when we reach our destination.
16. Parking and fuel/comfort stops – circle parking lot to clear all bikes from the road and park together.
17. Other Road Captain comments.
